- YouTube is free, and with 500 hours of content added per minute, it has more video options than any educational video platform could.
- Teachers can vett and select appropriate videos for their classes and use strategies to remove ads.
- MATs have limited budgets.

Why now?



91% of teachers now use YouTube in their classrooms. With the 2023 changes to *Keeping Students Safe in Education guidelines*, schools and MATs are required to proactively protect pupils from the risks associated with free streaming services. Paying for an educational video platform removes the risk.



73% of teachers have experienced inappropriate, embarrassing or unsafe content on YouTube during lessons. Teachers need access to safe, accurate, ad-free and classroom-appropriate videos that they don't need to spend time vetting.



Research shows teachers spend less than 5 -10 minutes searching for a video before playing it in class - not enough time to check for educational credibility. With the challenges of workload, teachers don't have time to properly watch and sift through inaccurate, outdated, inappropriate videos on YouTube.



The 2023 changes to the KCSiE guidance shifts safe, reliable classroom video content to a safeguarding as well as a curriculum priority. The cost of not prioritising safeguarding is too high for MATs and schools not to act.

By choosing a video learning platform with in-built lesson resources and formative assessment, MATs can replace other curriculum resources and reduce overall costs.


