Classroom integration



- **Enriching lessons:**
Align live programs with curriculum objectives for real-world context
- **Interactive activities:**

Learning extension



- **Independent research:**

- **Engaging content:**
Provide recorded programs for substitutes to ensure meaningful lessons
- **Discussion prompts:**
Include questions for substitutes to guide follow-up conversations

Holiday celebrations & special events



- **Cultural celebrations:**
Schedule trips on global traditions and historical holidays
- **Seasonal activities:**
Plan themed events, like pumpkin carving or National Poetry Month workshops

Library integration



- **Book extensions:**
